New Year Greetings!

One of the best things we can do to grow in our faith, as Christ-followers, is to dig into God's Word on a regular basis. So, as I've done in the past, I am challenging you--as your pastor/shepherd--to do just that. This year, we are offering three different reading plans that will help you continue on in your time in God's word, or get started in regular Bible time if this may be new to you. One entry-level reading plan is the New Testament Letters (Epistles) in a year. This one should be very do-able for anyone. A second reading plan will be the New Testament with Psalms and Proverbs for a year. This would be a little step up in reading, but again--should be do-able for anyone. The final (and the one we'll print in the newsletter each month) is the most challenging. Especially if you've been reading with me for the past couple years, you should be ready for this. It's a Bible-in-a-Year reading plan. This particular one is called 'historical'--a chronological reading of the entire Bible. (Also, there will be a discussion group meeting twice a month that will be discussing the readings, if you'd like to take part in that. Please see Deb Wiedmeyer for more information.) Thanks for considering this challenge! Again, I know of no better way for those seriously committed to growing as Disciples of Jesus Christ to do just that; get into God's word and see what a difference it makes in your life!

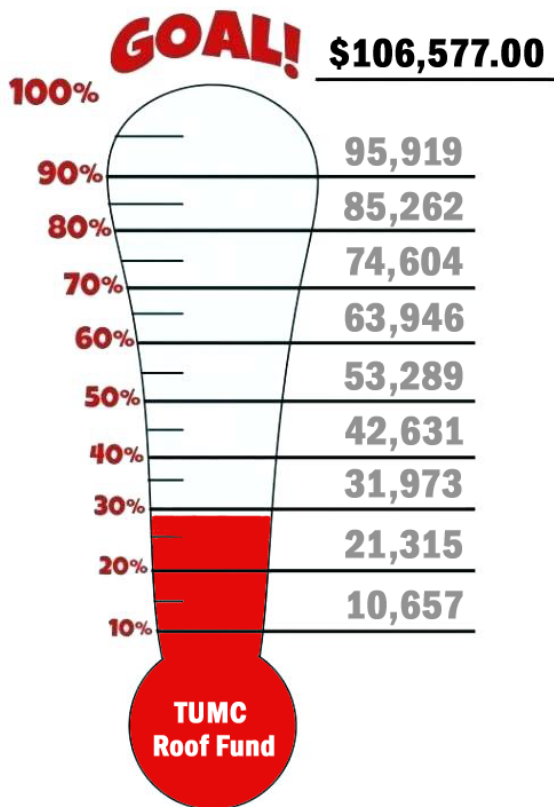
