Dear Trinity Methodist Family,

September Important Updates:

**1.** Global Methodist General Conference: From September 18-28, I will be attending our new denomination's first Global Methodist Church General Conference in Costa Rica. This historic event, themed "*So the World Will Know*," reflects our core mission and is inspired by Jesus' prayer for unity in John 17. I look forward to bringing back inspiring stories and valuable insights to share with all of you.

2. Contemporary Services: We are excited to introduce contemporary worship services starting October 27th, designed to enrich our worship experience and connect our community through music and message.

**3.** Educational Opportunities: This month, we are thrilled to distribute the Catechism of Christian Faith and Doctrine. I encourage everyone to engage with this material as it deepens our understanding of our beliefs. Additionally, our Adult Sunday School will explore "*Membership to Discipleship*" by Phil Maynard, with classes proposed for 7:45 AM or 10:30 AM on Sundays. Your input and participation are highly valued.

Bible Studies: A new Bible study group will begin on September 9, focusing on the teachings of Paul in the Epistle to the Romans, led by Bob Coulter, and the Women's Bible Study resumes on September 19, guided by Deb Wiedmeyer.

What does it mean to be a good church member or a faithful sibling in Christ? As we embrace the changes this month brings, let us keep our hearts and minds open to the ways God is moving in our lives. Together, let us step into this season of renewal with faith and anticipation for all the Lord has in store.

#### <u>Study of the Book of Romans</u>

Paul's Epistle to the Romans is widely considered Paul's most complete explanation of the Doctrine of Faith in Jesus Christ. Martin Luther stated that he was reborn through reading Romans. Luther considered Romans to be the 'Gemstone of the Bible'. John Wesley had his Aldersgate St. experience of having his "heart strangely warmed" after reading Paul's letter to the Romans.

Bob Coulter will facilitate a weekly one-hour study of the book of Romans beginning on Monday, September 9 at 1:00pm. Each weekly class will begin with a 30 minute video tape from the Les Feldick Ministries. Les is not a minister. He's a plain spoken Oklahoma farmer and rancher, who has an amazing way of making the Bible understandable to the average person. The second half hour of each class will be spent discussing the video we just watched.

#### Who will benefit from this class?

- People who have never participated in a Bible study.
- People who feel they need help understanding the Bible.
- People looking to strengthen their faith.
- People who have a good understanding of this book of doctrine but want to learn more.




