Dear Trinity Methodist Church Family,

The arrival of March brings with it the gentle whispers of change. After the bitter cold of February in Lomira, Wisconsin, we are reminded of God's power and the beauty of His creation, even in the harshest seasons. The frost-covered fields and icy winds have shown us both the strength of winter and the promise of spring. Just as the earth prepares for new life, so too are we called to prepare our hearts for a season of spiritual renewal.

This March, we enter the sacred season of Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025. Lent is a time to reflect, repent, and renew our faith. It is a journey of hope and determination—hope because we trust in God's unfailing love, and determination because we commit to growing closer

to Him. Psalm 147:11 reminds us, "The Lord delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love." Let us approach this season with open hearts, ready to live out our faith with greater integrity and joy as we prepare to suffer and die with Jesus Christ and celebrate His resurrection with Him.

We warmly invite you to join us every Wednesday at 7:00 PM for our Lenten services. This year, we will explore a special devotional series titled *A Journey of Spiritual Renewal*. The series begins on **Ash Wednesday, March 5**, where we will reflect on the devotional theme "Setting Intentions for Renewal", based on Matthew 6:1-6, 16-21. Each week, we will focus on themes of healing, commitment, and spiritual growth:

- Week 1 (March 12): "Renewing Our Commitment to Healing" (Matthew 6:1-6, 16-21)
- Week 2 (March 19): "Healing from Within" (John 5:1-18)
- Week 3 (March 26): "The Purity of Our Intentions" (Matthew 23:25-26)

These gatherings are a special time to reflect, pray, and grow together as we journey toward Easter. Your presence will enrich our community as we prepare our hearts for the sacred mysteries of Holy Week, including our Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services on April 17 and 18, 2025, at 7:00 PM.

Hebrews 10:25 says, "Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching." This call to gather and encourage one another is an important part of our faith journey. Together, let us come to encourage and build one another up in faith (1 Thessalonians 5:11).


Looking ahead, our Sunday sermons in March will focus on themes to inspire and challenge us:

HOW DO I SPEND ETERNITY IN HEAVEN?

Join us for the Study of the Book of Romans and find out.

Paul's Epistle to the Romans is widely considered Paul's most complete explanation of the Doctrine of Faith in Jesus Christ. Martin Luther stated that he was reborn through reading Romans. Luther considered Romans to be the 'Gemstone of the Bible.' John Wesley had his Aldersgate St.

experience of having his "heart strangely warmed" after reading Paul's letter to the Romans.

Bob Coulter will facilitate a weekly one hour study of the book of Romans beginning on Monday, March 3 at 1:00pm. Each weekly class will begin with a 30 minute video tape from the Les Feldick Ministries. Les is not a minister. He's a plain spoken Oklahoma farmer and rancher, who has an amazing way of making the Bible understandable to the average person. 
